

"They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers." (Acts 1:14)

What followed in chapter 2 was the coming of the Holy Spirit and 3,000 men coming to salvation and being baptized, not counting women and children. I'm just curious...... would we like to see 4,000 people come to salvation in our city after the preaching of just one sermon? Me too....

"They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.... And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved." (Acts 2:42, 47)

After salvation spread like wildfire in Jerusalem the new believers devoted themselves to a number of things...but note that prayer was a key aspect of that. What resulted? "The Lord added to their numbers daily those who were being saved." Would we like to experience what it is like to have people come to salvation and become part of our community of faith every day? Me too...

"Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. Stretch out your hand to heal and perform miraculous signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus." After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly." (Acts 4:29-31)

After their leaders had been arrested and told not to speak in the Name of Jesus any more under threat of physical harm and imprisonment the believers gathered for prayer. Notice what they prayed. Not that the persecution would stop. Not that they would be delivered from their enemies. They prayed for more boldness and for the Lord to do miracles so that the Gospel would be believed by the lost. What happened in that prayer meeting? The place was shaken....the believers were filled with the Holy Spirit....and they spoke the Word of God boldly out in the world. Would we like to see our prayer gatherings shaken? Would we like to be filled with the Holy Spirit together as a community of faith? Would we like to have a new boldness to speak the Word? Me too...

If we want to see all these things take place among us, we must pray.

Acts is the historical account of what happens when believers gather together and pray. We focus on the results but not the hard work that preceded them. The hardest work was not the preaching. It wasn't standing against persecution. It wasn't solving the logistical problems that came with explosive growth. The hardest work was prayer. And it resulted in the greatest move of God the world has ever known.

I've failed you. As your pastor I haven't prioritized prayer in our community. But over the last two years the Lord has moved on me to pray as the first and hardest work I do as your pastor. I'm not perfect but I'm praying. I'm convinced prayer must be the first work of the Church, the most important work of the church, and seen as the greatest source of all our power.

Now I'm calling you to pray. I'm calling on our Elders and our Deacons. I'm calling on our Staff and our volunteers. I'm calling on you in the pews. WE MUST BECOME PEOPLE OF PRAYER!


