Going Deeper - April 14, 2024

The 1st Love Project Week 2: The Keys To Success

Monday: Read 1 John 4:19; John 15:9-17. This week's Going Deeper is going to serve as a preparation guide for joining the Lord in His work during the 1st Love Project. As you recall, we asked that you not spend the money distributed to you this week until next Sunday, April 21st. We ask that you take the entirety of this week to pray along with your family so that you'll be as spiritually prepared as possible when the opportunity to minister comes. If you have a 4th through 12th grader in your household there is a devotional that is geared towards them in their money envelope. We provided this so that families could use it during their family devotional time with the Lord. This guide is for everyone else to use in their own time with the Lord. Let's commit to take full advantage of it this week.

Tuesday: Read John 15:16; Matthew 21:22; 1 John 5:14-15. Prayer is the key to what we are going to be doing. Prayer is going to prepare the heart of the person you'll be investing your money into. Prayer will open their heart to the Gospel more than the money you give them will. The money is simply the tool we are using to demonstrate God's love to them in a practical way. Jesus told us that we have been chosen to go and bear fruit for Him. Not only that, but that if we will obey, that fruit will be fruit that will last. Part of the process for bearing fruit that will last is that we boldly ask the Father for things in Jesus' Name. We need to boldly ask for the Lord to use us for His Glory in Jesus' Name. We need to ask for salvations in Jesus' Name. We need to ask for the Kingdom to be advanced in Jesus' Name. We need to ask for our resources to be multiplied in Jesus' Name. And we need to ask that we will be transformed by this project in Jesus' Name! We have been promised that the Father will give us whatever we ask of Him in Jesus' Name! Let's take Him at His word and join Him in prayer! Stop what you are doing and take the next 10 minutes and pray!

Wednesday: Read John 6:1-14. The next step in the preparation process is for us to evaluate what we've been given and whether or not we should add to it. If you are part of a family, take all the money that each person received in their envelope and set it out in different piles. Identify how much money each person has and then how much you would all have if you combined your money. This is a good baseline for us to start with. The next step is to ask the Lord if you should match that amount of money from your own resources, either individually or as a family. Given that our congregation has been called to this project for this season I would encourage you to think of this question in a different way: Ask the Lord if there is any reason that you shouldn't double the money you have been given. We think it is a safe assumption that we should do so unless He tells us otherwise. Stop and pray right now! "Lord, You have given me this amount of money. Is there any reason I shouldn't double this amount of money so that it can be used during the 1st Love Project? If yes, please make that clear to us. If not, will you please make provision for us to obey you and double this money. We won't be able to obey you if you don't make provision. In Jesus' Name, Amen!" The Lord may not give you the answer right away but we believe that He will make it clear to you over the next few days. Pay attention to what He is telling you.

Thursday: Read 2 Samuel 24:18-25. Now let's think about sacrificing to participate in the 1st Love Project (FLP). What are some things that you can say 'no' to over the next three weeks so that you'll be able to save some money for the Lord's use? Do have birthday money in a wallet somewhere? Do you have coins in a piggy bank you could cash in? How about agreeing to not eat out the next three weeks after Sunday Service and put that money towards the FLP? Can you do without a drink from the vending machine or a month's subscription to Disney Plus? Could you fast off of lunch and save that money? Whatever He tells you, agree to sacrifice that together and then add that money to the pot for use during the FLP.

Friday: Read Isaiah 55:6-9, Acts 8:26-40. The last step in the process is to ask the Lord to lay someone on your heart that you should invest this money in. Ask your children if anyone comes to mind. Listen to what they share with you. Think about whether you should each invest in someone or combine your resources to bless someone in a big way. If you don't sense the Lord laying someone on your heart, ask Him to speak clearly to you when that person comes your way over the next two weeks. Pray for a divine appointment with the right person. Ask the Lord to align your circumstances to prove that this is the right person to give your money to. And ask that when you know the right person that you will be bold to give it to them in Jesus' Name. Tell them that you have been deeply loved by Jesus and that you want to demonstrate His love to them in return. Ask that you'll have the chance to share the Gospel with them if they are willing to hear more. This is the most critical part of your preparation process during the FLP so take it seriously!
